1. MONITORING OF OFFICIAL UNIVERSITY PROGRAMMES IN THE VALENCIAN COMMUNITY

By resolution of 15 October 2025 of the Presidency, approving the 2025 call for applications for the evaluation and monitoring of official university degree programmes at bachelor's, master's and doctoral levels in the Valencian Community (DOGV, 22 October 2025), setting out the deadlines, the documentation to be submitted and the procedure to be followed. The universities of the Valencian Community submitted a total of 65 programmes for evaluation under this call.

4. INSTITUTIONAL ACCREDITATION

During 2025, AVAP received two applications for institutional accreditation, both from the University of Alicante: the Faculty of Sciences and the Faculty of Economics and Business Studies.

AVAP issued a positive (binding) report for each of the applicant faculties, which was sent in April to the General Secretariat for Universities.

As regards applications for SAIC certification, AVAP has so far received five applications in 2025:

TEACHING STAFF ASSESSMENT



1. EVALUATION OF THE RESEARCH ACTIVITY OF CONTRACTED TEACHING AND RESEARCH STAFF

Throughout 2025, AVAP, through its committees of experts, has evaluated the research activity of contract academic staff at the Miguel Hernández University of Elche. This evaluation is carried out using a procedure and evaluation criteria comparable to those used by the CNEAI to evaluate academic staff belonging to university teaching bodies.

A total of 29 applications were assessed during the year.

In 2025, the Alicante Institute for Health and Biomedical Research (ISABIAL) also requested that AVAP evaluate the research activity of its research staff.

2. ASSESSMENT OF ADDITIONAL REMUNERATION FOR UNIVERSITY LECTURERS

In accordance with the provisions of Decree 174/2002 of the Valencian Government and the Resolution of 21 January 2011 of AVAP Presidency, it is the responsibility of AVAP to assess individual merits for the purpose of establishing additional remuneration linked to the individual teaching, research and management merits of civil servant teaching and research staff, as regulated by Decree 174/2002 of 15 October of the Valencian Government.

AVAP assesses the mobility component, classifying it into three different quality levels.

In 2025, 103 applications were assessed for the classification of university teaching staff mobility:
